Packaging instructions

These packaging instructions describe the methods required to pack a system computer for shipping. They apply to all system computers of the Viscom AG.

The instructions consist of the following sections:

- Packaging the system computer (Page 4)
- Liability (Page 9)

Packaging the system computer

Perform the following work steps:

1. Remove the computer from the system.



2. Take a sheet of ESD-capable bubble wrap large enough for the system computer and wrap the computer with it completely.



3. Fasten the bubble wrap with packing tape.



4. Select a shipping carton large enough for the computer.



5. First, place a material suitable for cushioning the computer (Intellpack, Tunpack etc.) into the carton.



6. Place the computer upon it.



7. Protect the two upper edges of the computer with a suitable cushioning material.



8. Close the carton and turn it over.
9. Open the bottom of the carton and remove the cushioning material that was placed there.



10. Protect the two lower edges of the computer with a suitable cushioning material.



11. Seal the carton as prescribed.



✓ The system computer is packed and ready to ship.
